Opening Plenary—Sunday, May 5

AIDS Research: Where We've Been & Where We're Going

Luncheon Plenary—Monday, May 6

Youth & HIV Prevention: New Directions
This plenary will focus broadly on the science of HIV prevention in youth, policy approaches to HIV comprehensive and abstinence-based programs, and youth perspectives. The plenary will be facilitated to allow different points of view to be expressed, and to allow an honest and open exchange of perspectives. **Speakers include Scott Evertz, Patricia Funderburk Ware, and Lloyd Kolbe.**

Closing Plenary—Monday, May 6

The Ryan White CARE Act: Lessons Learned
This session will focus broadly on lessons learned from a decade of supporting comprehensive HIV services for families and individuals affected by HIV/AIDS. A researcher, provider, administrator and consumer perspective will be presented during the plenary, with an important focus on lessons learned in order to enhance the delivery of comprehensive HIV services in the third decade of the epidemic.
