

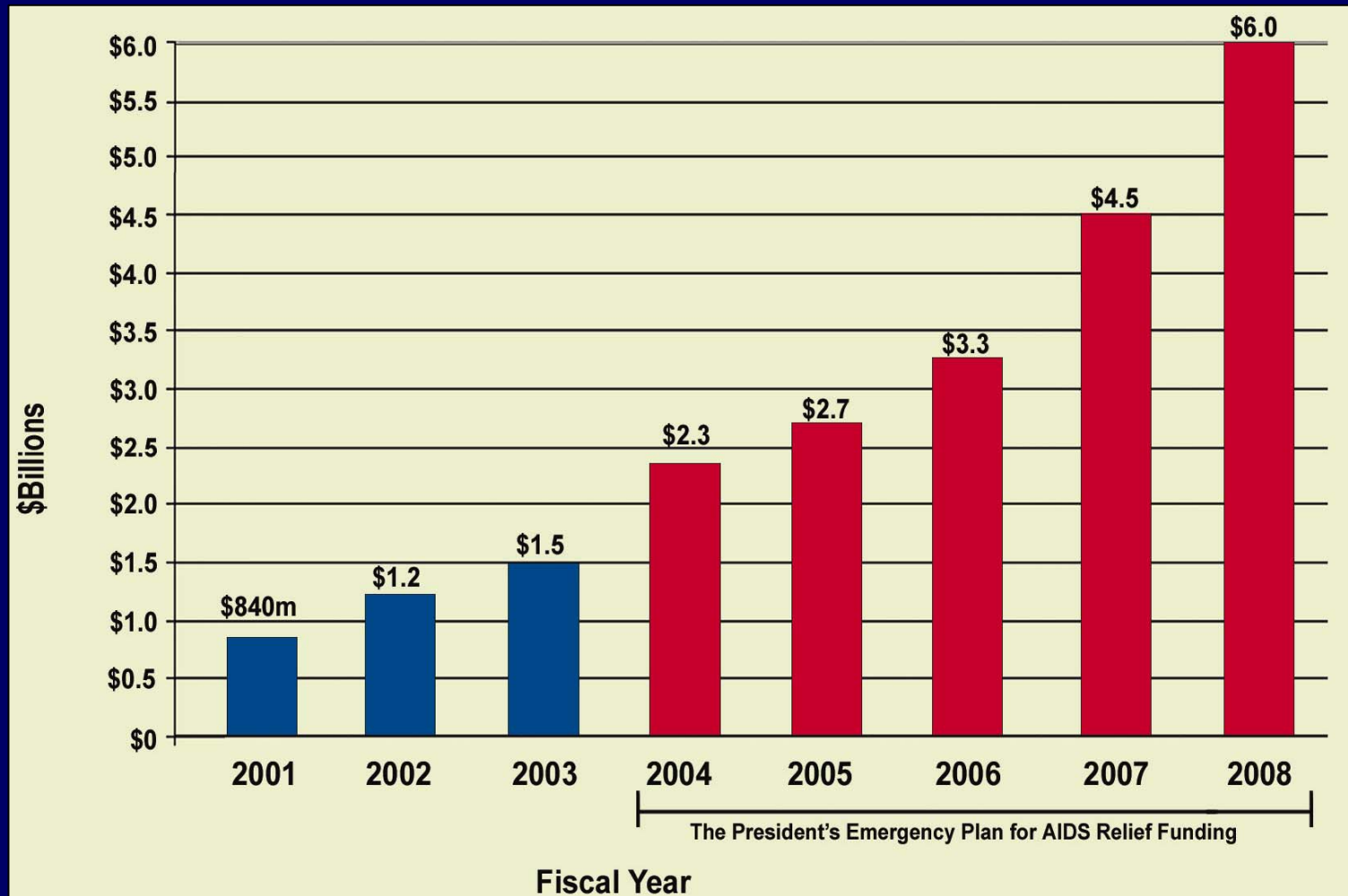

Recent USG Spending on Global HIV/AIDS

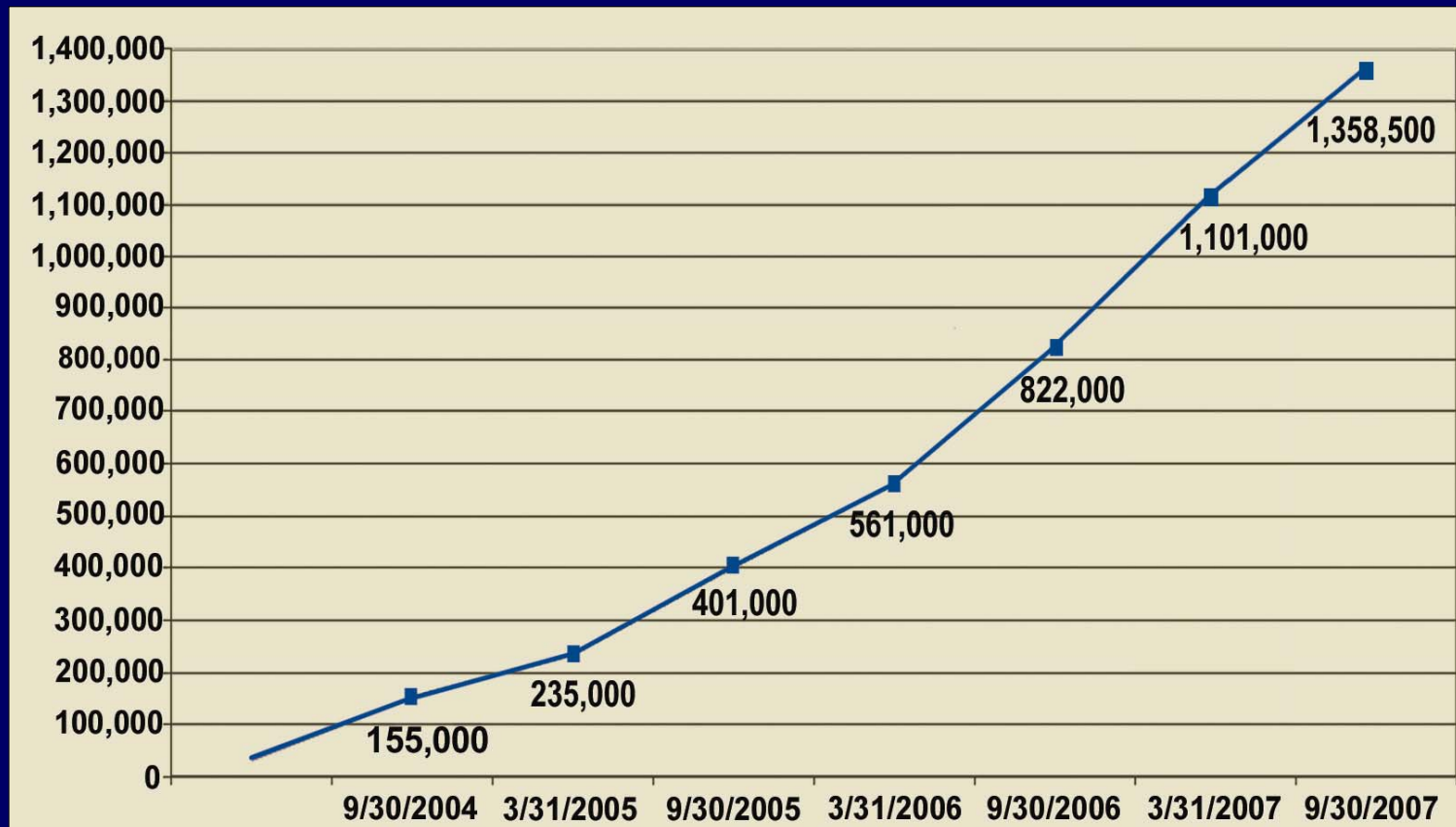


By the end of fiscal year 2008, the American people will have invested **\$18.8 billion** in the global fight against HIV/AIDS.

Development Partner Coordination

What is Working?

- Country coordination of development partners around one national plan
 - Shared vision, shared goals
 - Leadership and country ownership
 - Transparency
 - Trust and mutual respect
- PEPFAR Country Operational Plans
- Global Fund technical assistance to address bottlenecks and strengthen CCMs
- Coordinated procurement and supply chain
- Greater civil society involvement on CCMs



Development Partner Coordination

What is Not Working?

- When a procurement partner underperforms
- Prevention (combination prevention)
- Participation and transparency on Country Coordination Mechanism (CCM)



Development Partner Coordination What Next?

- Invest in coordination itself
- Partnership Compacts: a framework for coordination
