As Director of Monitoring and Evaluation, PAUL DELAY develops authoritative country-by-country estimates of the epidemic's extent and characteristics. He joined UNAIDS in 2003 from the U.S. Agency for International Development, where he was Senior Advisor on HIV/AIDS and Chief of the HIV/AIDS Division. During eight of his 13 years as a practicing clinical physician, he was Medical Director of Refugee Medical Services for the City of San Francisco. From 1988 to 1993, he worked for the World Health Organization's Global Programme on AIDS, primarily in Malawi. He studied Medicine at the University of California and the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine.
