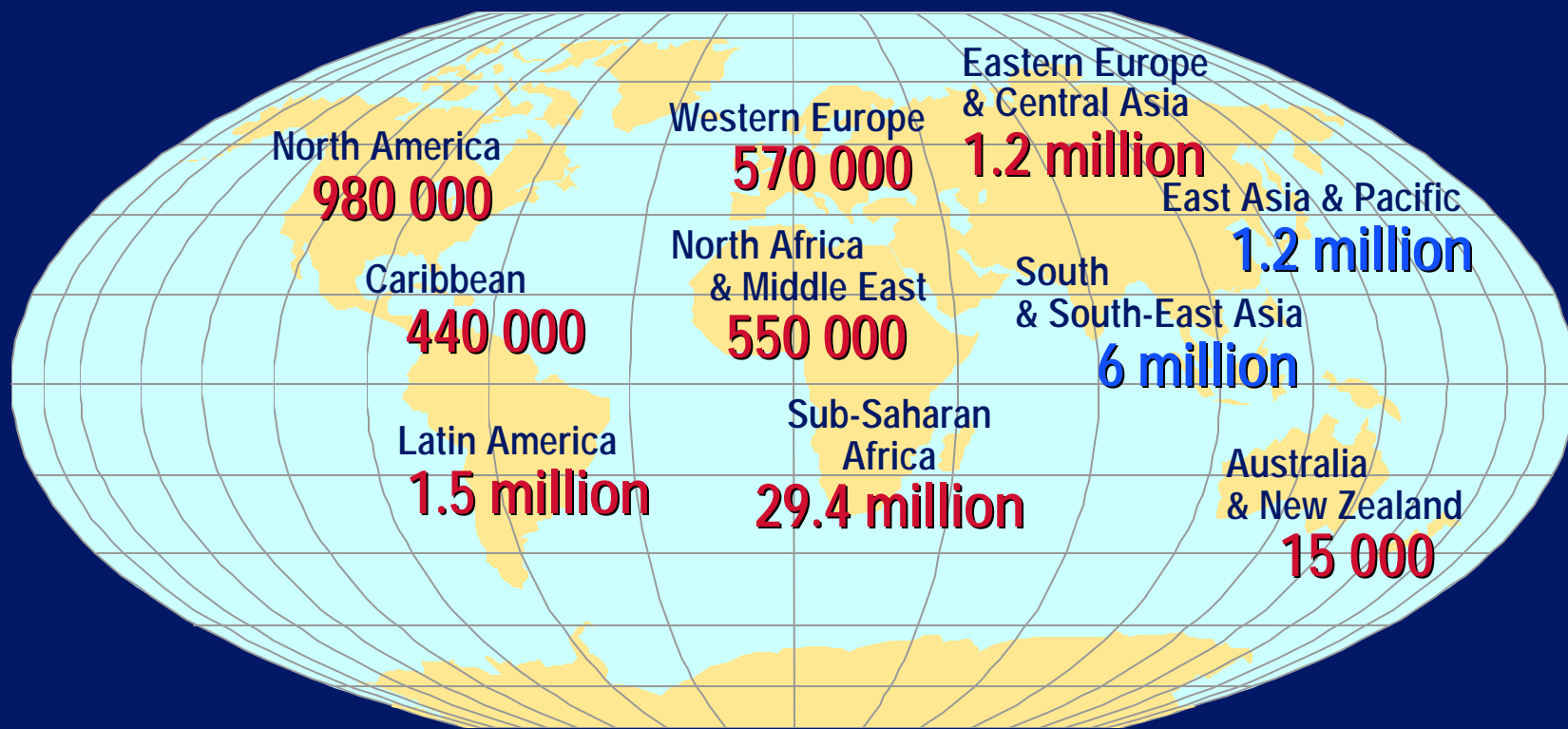

# Global estimates for adults and children end 2002

- People living with HIV/AIDS ..... **42 million**
- New HIV infections in 2002 ..... **5 million**
- Deaths due to HIV/AIDS in 2002 ..... **3.1 million**

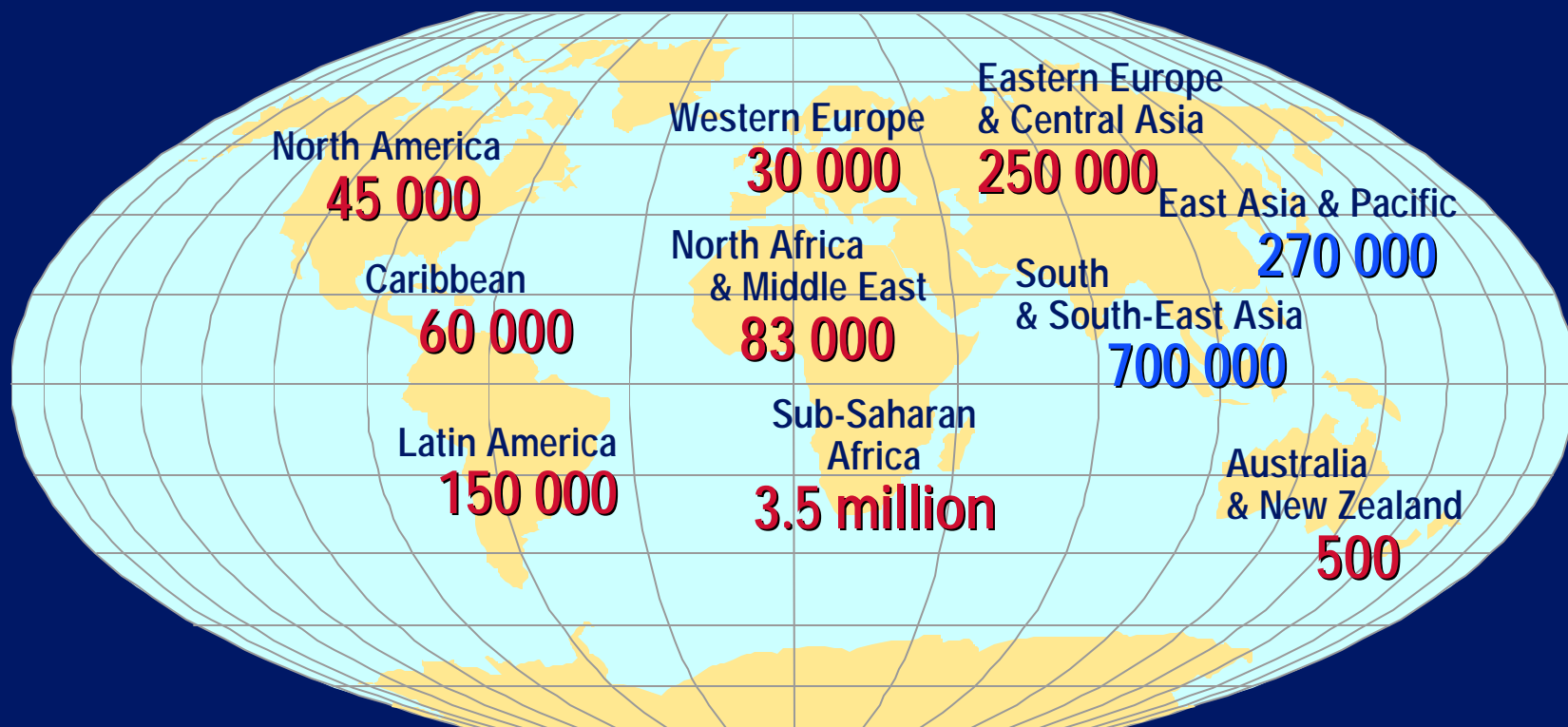


# Adults and children estimated to be living with HIV/AIDS as of end 2002



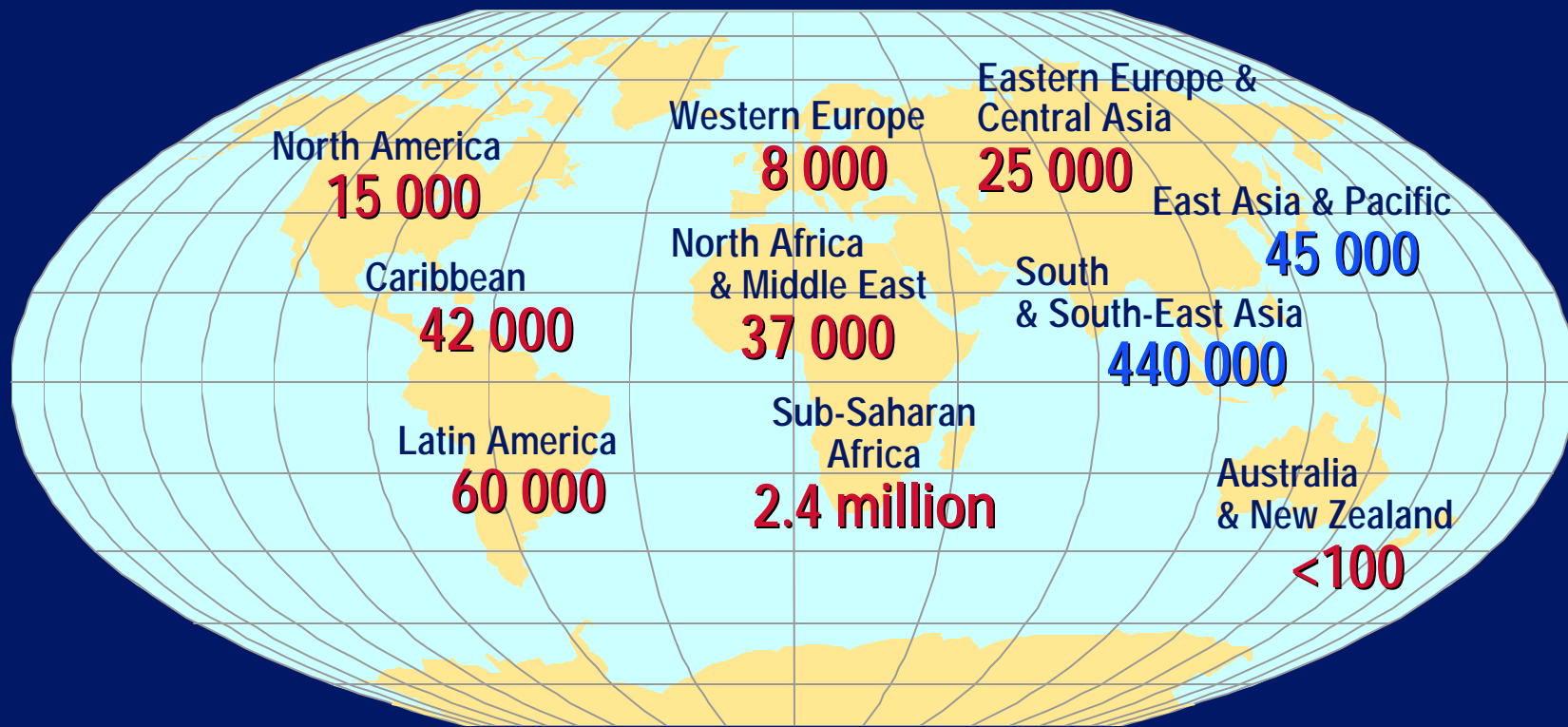
**Total: 42 million**

# Estimated number of adults and children newly infected with HIV during 2002



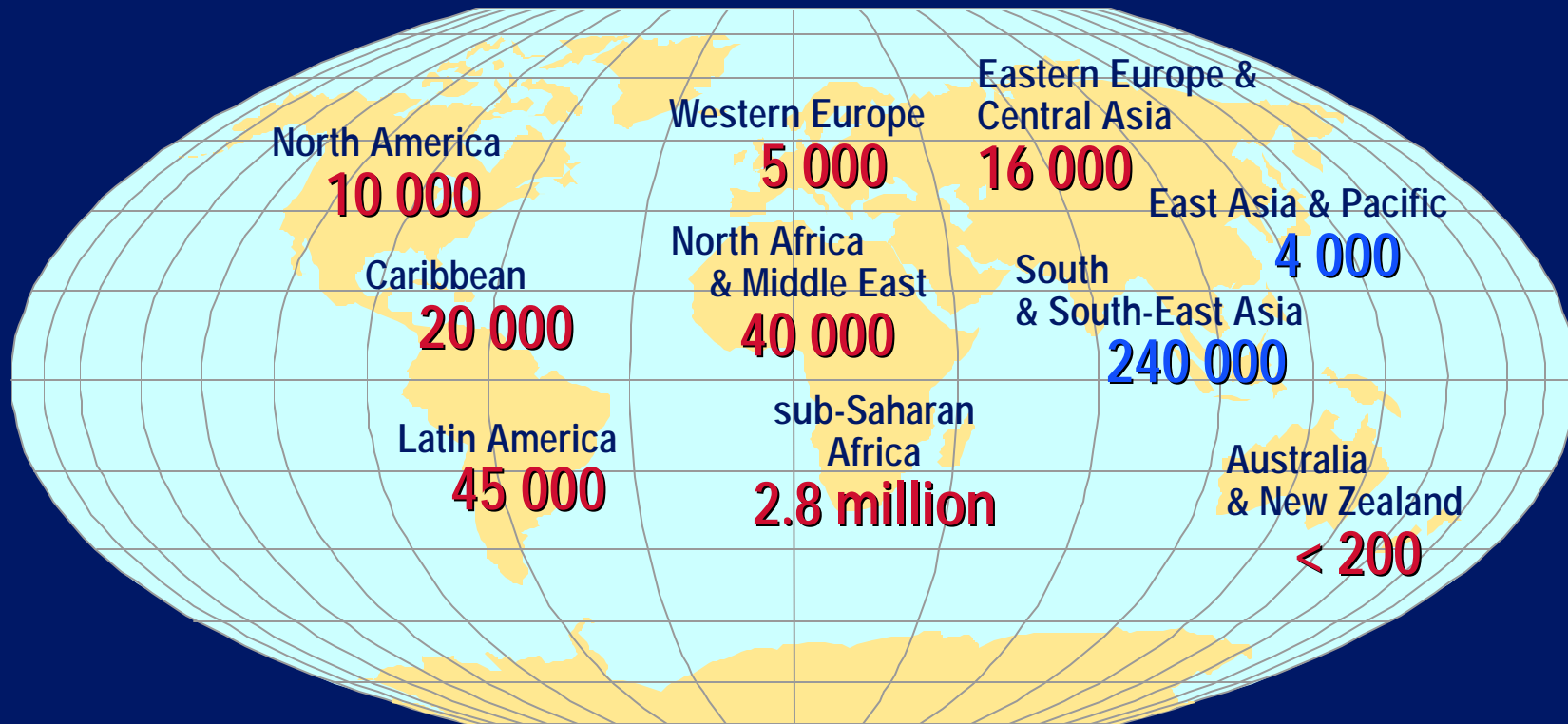
**Total: 5 million**

# Estimated adult and child deaths from HIV/AIDS during 2002



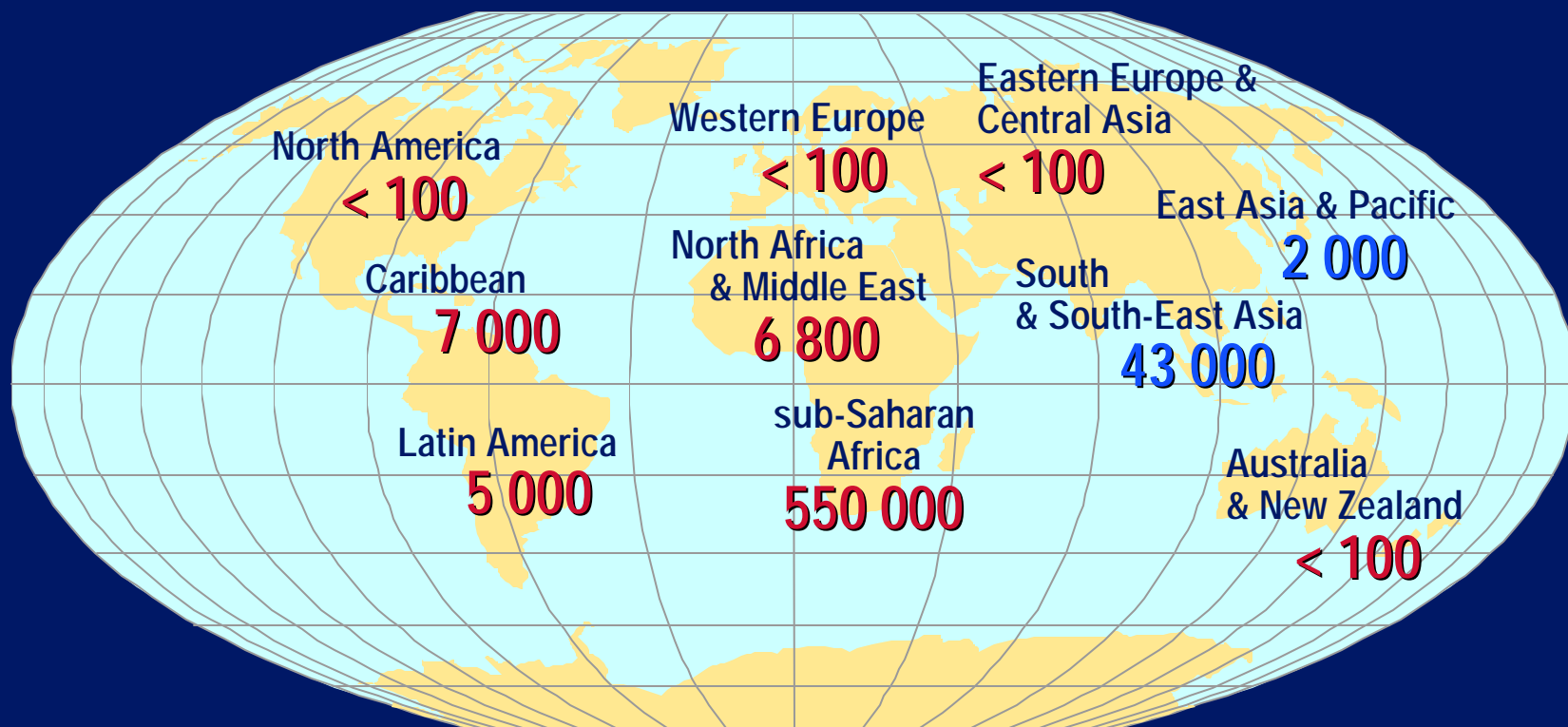
**Total: 3.1 million**

# Children (<15 years) estimated to be living with HIV/AIDS as of end 2002



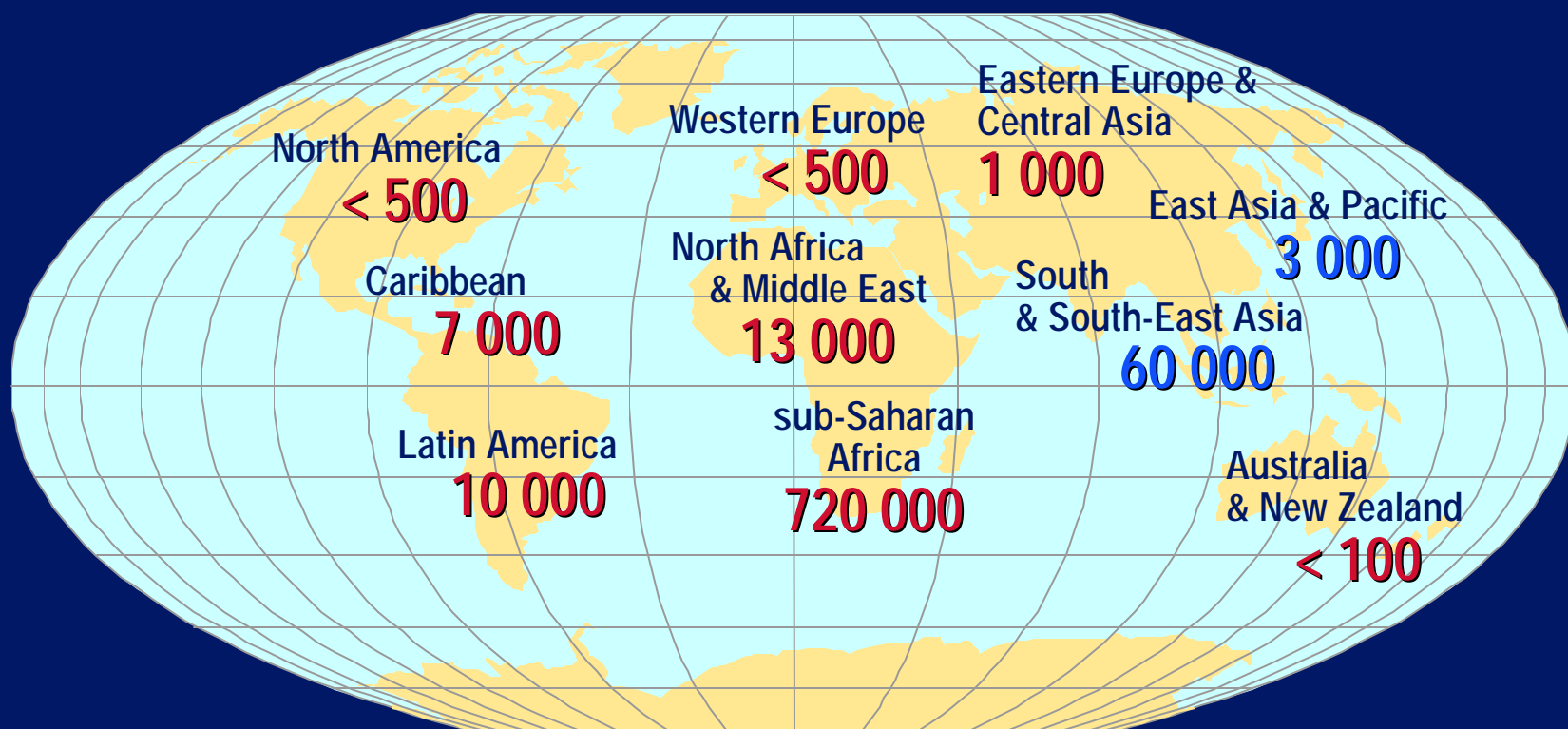
**Total: 3.2 million**

# About 14 000 new HIV infections a day in 2002

- More than 95% are in developing countries
- 2000 are in children under 15 years of age
- About 12 000 are in persons aged 15 to 49 years, of whom:
  - almost 50% are women
  - about 50% are 15–24 year olds



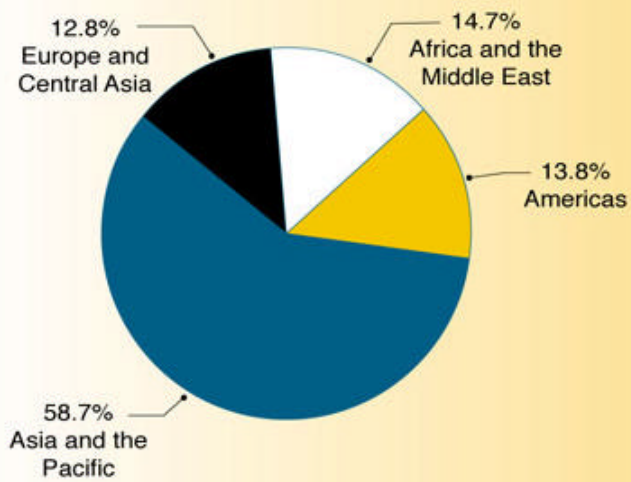
# End-2002 global HIV/AIDS estimates

## Children (<15 years)

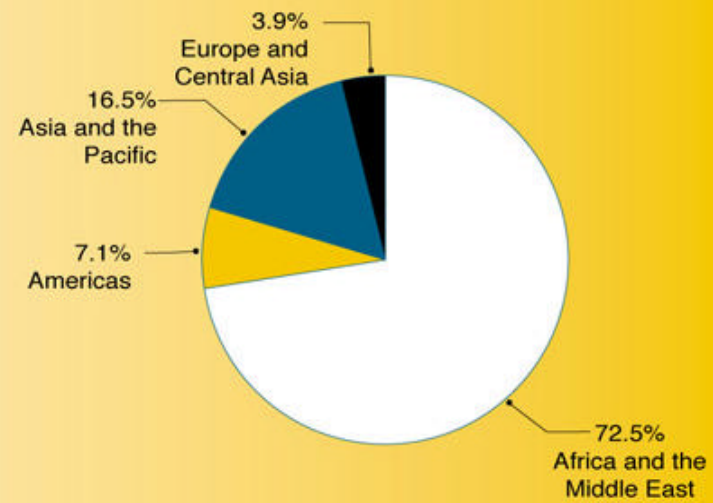
- Children living with HIV/AIDS ..... **3.2 million**
- New HIV infections in 2002 ..... **800 000**
- Deaths due to HIV/AIDS in 2002 ..... **610 000**
