

## ***Capitol Hill Briefing Series on Women's Health Policy***

Women's health needs and economic circumstances make health coverage and access to care important throughout their lives. They are disproportionately affected by changes in policies that impact both the private and public sectors. To provide policymakers with up-to-date information and allow for an interchange of ideas with experts in the field, the Henry J. Kaiser Family Foundation, in partnership with Women's Policy, Inc., is launching a new Capitol Hill briefing series on women's health policy. Some of the future briefings will address health insurance coverage and access for low-income women; women and HIV; and older women's health issues, including caregiving, long-term care, and Medicare.
