VIP Speaker Bios

Mony PEN (Cambodia), *Social Mobilization and Communication Advisor, Cambodian Community of Women Living with HIV/AIDS*

Mony Pen is an activist and advocate for HIV-positive women in Cambodia and globally. In 2004, she joined the Asia Pacific Network of People Living with HIV/AIDS (APN+) as the focal point for HIV-positive women in Cambodia, and in 2007 she assumed the position of Social and Communication Advisor for the Cambodian Community of Women Living with HIV/AIDS. In 2006, Ms. Pen served as the representative for APN+ women on the board of the Global Network of People Living with HIV/AIDS (GNP+). She is currently on the regional advisory committee of the Collaborative Fund/International Treatment Preparedness Coalition (ITPC) for Southeast Asia. Ms. Pen co-founded the Positive Women of Hope Organization and acts as a voluntary advisor and facilitator for the Research Institute for Development in Cambodia. She is a dedicated advocate for improving the quality of life for people living with HIV/AIDS, reducing stigma and discrimination, and ensuring access to treatment and care for all.
